To Parents/Guardians and Students:

As summer approaches, the Hazlet Township School District encourages our students to choose reading as one of the many activities they enjoy while on break from school. Summer reading helps children to continue to develop skills and practice strategies that they have learned during the school year, and everyone loves a good book!

For the summer of 2019, we would like to invite our rising fifth- and sixth-graders to participate in the Scholastic Read-a-Palooza Summer Reading Challenge, “a free, online reading program designed to help students turn the ‘summer slide’ – the learning loss which can occur over the summer months – into a ‘summer leap’ by discovering the joy of reading for fun.” This year, the challenge runs from Monday, May 6th through Friday, September 6th.

To participate in the program, students will read books of their choosing and will enter their minutes read on the Scholastic Summer Reading Challenge website. As students complete weekly reading challenges, digital rewards are unlocked. Participating students will receive certificates at the conclusion of the program. In addition, the school with the most minutes read in each state will be recognized by Scholastic. Best of all, our students will reap the benefits of reading!

Students that are unable to enter their minutes online may complete the paper log sheets and turn them in to their teachers by September 6th. Log sheets should be submitted only for reading minutes that have not been entered online.
