## CAFETERIA POINT-OF-SALE DEBIT SYSTEM

- NOW TIED INTO REALTIME, THIS SYSTEM ALLOWS DEBIT ACCOUNTS FOR PURCHASES
- PAYMENTS ARE MADE IN ADVANCE – NO MORE LUNCH TICKETS
- ALL STUDENTS ARE ISSUED AN IDENTIFICATION CARD WHICH CORRESPONDS TO THEIR FOOD SERVICE ACCOUNT
- PURCHASES ARE RECORDED BY USE OF THE STUDENT CARD
- STUDENTS STILL HAVE THE OPTION TO PAY CASH ON A DAILY BASIS

### **THINGS TO REMEMBER:**

REMIND YOUR CHILD THAT THEY CAN ONLY USE THE SYSTEM IF YOU HAVE DEPOSITED FUNDS FOR THEIR USE OR IF THEY RECEIVE FREE OR REDUCED MEALS.

ANY MONEY NOT SPENT AT THE END OF THE SCHOOL YEAR WILL BE AVAILABLE NEXT YEAR.

YOU MAY SEND IN MONEY AT ANY TIME FOR YOUR CHILD'S ACCOUNT BY USING THE FORM BELOW.

### **PLACING MONEY IN STUDENT ACCOUNTS**

**How do I put money on my child's account?** During the school year you can send money to school with your child. Your child can then give their envelope to the homeroom teacher who will forward all cafeteria money to the school office. The cafeteria manager collects all payments in the morning from the office. For security reasons, we recommend that advanced payments be sent in the form of a check. Please write the student's name on the check. For making a payment, use the form at the bottom of this page. For future deposits, please use the form available on the school website. A letter will be given to your child when their balance is running low.

**My child is approved for free meals.** Your child will have an account just like every other student in the school. They will be identified by the POS System through their ID card. It will scanned just like the paid cards and so the meal can be accounted for.

**My child is approved for reduced meals.** Your child will have an account just like every other student. We encourage you to place money in their account. The student will be identified by the POS System with their ID card and \$ .40 will be deducted from the account, or the student can pay \$0.40 daily.

**How much money may I deposit?** You determine the amount that is right for you. There is no limit to the amount of money that can be deposited into a debit account. We recommend that you deposit enough money for at least two weeks meals to reduce paperwork and time for both you and the food service staff.
