PRESCHOOL REGISTRATION 2018-2019



Application for the Hazlet preschool program is for income eligible and tuition-based three and four year old children, who will be selected through a lottery process. For the 2018-2019 school year, the preschool program will be offered to **children who were born after September 30, 2014 and on or before October 1, 2015.**

The preschool program offered at Sycamore Drive Early Childhood Learning Center utilizes The Creative Curriculum Gold Edition. This curriculum focuses on communication, cognitive and academic readiness, adaptive, social and emotional, motor and sensory development skills. Collaboration between family and staff members is encouraged and considered essential to the success of our students.

The District provides a half-day, five days per week preschool program. The morning session time is 8:50-11:15 a.m. and the afternoon session time is 12:20-2:45 p.m. Transportation is the responsibility of the parent. Please contact Right at School for Before and After Care services, if needed at 855-287-2466.

Registration for income eligible and tuition-based students will be held at **Sycamore Drive Early Childhood Learning Center on January 10, 11, and 12 (Wed., Thurs. & Fri.) from 9:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.** If you are not able to register at this time, please call Sycamore Drive Early Childhood Learning Center at 732-264-2180. Applications for the lottery will be accepted until February 14, 2018 at 3:30 p.m. An interpreter will be provided upon request. To register, you must provide the following **in person**:

- Original birth certificate with a raised seal
- Immunization record, Copy of most recent physical
- Proof of guardianship (if applicable)
- Proofs of residency:
 - ✓ **One of the following**: property tax bill, mortgage statement, deed, contracts of sale, leases, signed letter from landlords and other evidence of property ownership, tenancy or residency
 - ✓ **Three of the following**: utility bills, driver's license, financial account information, delivery receipts, voter registration, permits and other evidence of personal attachment to a particular location

Preschool Program

The lottery preschool program is based on availability. A limited number of tuition paying children will be selected by a lottery process. The lottery process is a random drawing conducted by a lottery panel. The available lottery slots are filled as the panel draws the names from the lottery pool of applications. Applications for the lottery will be accepted up to 3:30 p.m. on Wednesday, February 14, 2018. The lottery drawing will be held on Thursday, February 15, 2018 at 3:45 p.m., in the Sycamore Drive ECLC gym, if necessary. You do not need to be present at the lottery drawing. All applicants will be notified by mail. Tuition for the five day per week, half-day program is \$2600.00, which is paid in ten monthly payments.

Income Eligible Preschool

A free preschool education program will be available to a limited number of students whose families are income eligible. An application must be completed to determine eligibility. **Eligibility for income eligible preschool students will be determined on a first come, first serve basis.**
