Eligible Students

- Required for ECA students
- Open to current 8th-grade or 9th-grade students taking/passing Algebra I

Format

This course will utilize a blended learning model that incorporates the APEX online platform with in-person support. Apex Learning provides a digital curriculum to meet the needs of every student while the in-person instruction provides support for students to take an active role in their learning.

Grading and Testing

Students must pass the online component of the course and pass the Raritan High School Honors Geometry final exam in order to be eligible to enroll in Algebra II for the 2019 - 2020 school year. Students must also take the NJSLA Geometry assessment (3 units).

Required Face-to-Face Meetings

- Initial APEX training at HMS in June during the school day
- Students are required to attend a minimum of 12 face-to-face sessions between July 8th and August 1st but are encouraged to attend as many sessions as their schedule permits
- The final exam will be given on August 5th (APEX coursework must be completed by August 1st)
- PARCC Geometry exam given on August 6th and 7th
